ITINERARY:

Thursday morning ~10 am: Arrive on time and load up! We will set sail from Newport Beach at 11am. The sail is about 26 miles and depending on the wind and seas takes about 4 - 5 hours. Snacks and liquid refreshments will be provided over and back. Feel free to BYOB.

Friday morning: You choose your fun: rent a golf cart (for 4 or 6) and cruise the island. play golf, go out on the Extreme Cape Canyon Expedition, scuba dive or snorkel, tour the casino, perhaps zipline, go to the beach or just wander the quaint town of Avalon. The day ends with our group taking a sunset sail, wine [limited] included.

Saturday morning: We start with mimosas and sail to Two Harbors for lunch at the West End Galley. Afterwards, a short hike for pictures from the spine of the island. Midafternoon, we sail the high seas if the wind is up, or find a cove, anchor & play in the water. BYOB.

Sunday morning: We set sail back to the mainland. We expect to be driving home to Phx by 2pm. Traffic should be light, as it's Sunday.
